### Southern Charm.... Charleston and Savannah

DAY 1...Our adventure begins. Sit back, enjoy the scenery, and make new friends. Today's journey will end in Pigeon Forge. Dinner is included followed by the evening show at the **Comedy Barn Theatre.** D

DAY 2...Today we head to Charleston. Dinner is included this evening at one of Charleston's fine restaurants. B, D

DAY 3...Time to start touring. Depart with local guide for a **Historic Charleston Tour**. Experience this diverse southern city which blends French, English, West African and traditional Southern American Cultures into the music, art, food, and lifestyle. As we make our way around Charleston, our guide will share history about the **Historic City Market**. The City Market is a historic market complex in downtown Charleston. Established in the 1790's, the market stretches for four city blocks. While touring we will stop by the Citadel. The **Citadel**, with its iconic picturesque campus, offers a classic military college education for your men and women focused on leadership excellence and academic distinction. As we drive around the campus, we will make a stop at the Chapel (if open and no events are taking place). Next stop is at the **Charleston Tea Plantation**. We will be greeted by a staff member who will guide us through the "Learn About Tea Tour". A trolley ride is included to see the acres of tea bushes, as well as, a stop at the greenhouse. Included in our tour is the **Angel Oak Viewing.** the Angel Oak Park is located on Johns Island where you can find what is known as "A Lowcountry Treasure". It is considered to be the largest Live Oak Tree east of the Mississippi estimated to be 300 to 400 years old. Dinner is included this evening. B, L, D

DAY 4....Today we will enjoy a **Historic Charleston Carriage Tour.** Explore historic downtown Charleston with a friendly, engaging guide, a beautiful horse, and a comfortable carriage for a memorable 1-hour carriage ride through history. Time on own in the **Old City Market** for lunch and shopping. Off we go to **Boone Hall Plantation and Gardens.** Tour the first floor to see how this Georgian-designed home blends recovered materials and antique furnishings to recreate an atmosphere that would have surrounded a Coastal Carolina planter's family and guests. Next, we will enjoy **"Exploring the Gullah Culture".** Boone Hall is the only plantation in the Charleston area to present a live presentation of this unique culture adapted by African slaves. True descendants of the Gullah people present the history of this culture through storytelling, song, and dance that is at times educational, at times entertaining, and at times...very moving and emotional Dinner is included this evening. B, D

Day 5....All Aboard. Today we head toward Savannah. Meet our step-on guide for a **Historic Savannah Tour.** You get it all on this tour—moss-draped oaks, stately mansions, beautiful squares, expansive riverfront and over 270 years of history. Lunch on own in **City Market.** After lunch, enjoy guided tour of **Tybee Island Lighthouse** and overview of **Tybee Island with Beach Walk**. Tybee, which meant "salt" to the Native Americans, is the northernmost barrier island along the Georgia Colonial Coast. Tybee is an eclectic small beach town offering a little nostalgic and a little new. Time to check into our hotel. Dinner tonight at Lady and Sons, Paula Deens's Flagship restaurant. B, D

Day 6...We will enjoy **The Historic Beaufort Tour** with our guide. Beaufort is a city of striking mansions of pre-Revolutionary and pre-Civil War eras. Beaufort is also known for the major motion pictures filmed there including "The Big Chill" and "Forrest Gump". Our tour will include a visit to **Parris Island Marine Base** where some 20,000 men and women complete their training each year. Highlights at the Marine Base will be the Iwo Jima Monument, Parade Field, and the Parris Island Museum. Lunch on own with free time in Beaufort Historic District. Dinner is included this evening. Day 7...Time to say good-by to Savannah. Travel to Drury Inn, Knoxville, TN. "Kick-Back" dinner at Drury included. B, D.
